

A good collection, but why O'Neill's *Desire Under the Elms* rather than one of the big three (*Iceman, Moon, Long Day's*)? Why *All My Sons* by Miller rather than *Death of a Salesman* or *The Crucible*? Why Glaspell's *Verge* at all, when Inge and Rice, much better playwrights, are left out entirely?

I had to buy this book for a class. I liked how much was compiled into one book. The intros about the authors and commentary on their works were a nice touch.

This book is essential to anyone who is willing to start studies on modern drama. It brings a wonderful selection of 25 plays, from Ibsen's *A Doll's House* (1879) to Wasserstein's *The Sisters Rosenweig* (1992), and featuring other authors such as Wilde, Shaw, Pirandello, Brecht and

Ionesco. It also includes a second part of critical essays by the main drama authors and critics from the XX century.
