

The Palestinians are the aborigines of Palestine. The Jews, native to Ur in Iraq, claimed their land once before...in biblical times. But as Ms. Hammad succinctly points out "god ain't no real estate agent." A fantastic book for understanding Arab emotions on the subject of Palestine.
