

This little book is fascinating! As a Ricardian I am often asked "Well, what about those bones they found in the Tower - weren't they the 'Princes in the Tower'?" After having read widely I firmly believed they were not (owing to the depth they were buried and archaeologists' opinions), but I never considered the interesting idea of them being basically a fraud, created for political purposes. Richard Unwin raises intriguing questions and attempts to provide plausible scenarios for his theory. I suppose we may never know for sure, unless in the future the bones are allowed to be tested, but

in the meantime this theory is compelling.
